This special issue reports a selection of topics from the XI conference of the Italian Colour Group (Gruppo del Colore – <http://www.gruppodelcolore.it>) held in Milano in 2015, extended and submitted to JAIC.

Gruppo del Colore, the Italian Colour Group, was established in 2004 and held his first annual conference in Pescara in 2005. This multidisciplinary group has been founded enlarging the pre-existing Group of Colorimetry and Reflectoscopy (SIOF) founded in 1995 by Claudio Oleari. This multidisciplinary enlargement to all the possible applications of colour has been deeply inspired by the AIC and by the Colour Group (Great Britain).

Now Gruppo del Colore is a much bigger group, compared to 2005, with a mailing list of around 500 persons and Milano conference had the submission of more than 100 papers.

We are glad to introduce this special issue to report some of the most interesting papers of the conference, reporting in this way the progression of the Italian Colour Group to the much wider audience of the Journal of AIC.
